11:35 – 11:40	<p style="text-align: center;">AB82/SB18 Update</p> <p>Katy reported that the Department of Public Health was given money from the State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) a grant for outreach and enrollment (AB82) and outreach and retention (SB18). Through an RFP process the grants have been subcontracted to Healthy House and Livingston Community Health.</p>
11:40 – 11:45	<p style="text-align: center;">Prevention Action Team & State Legislative Update</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The August 13, 2015 action with Assemblyman Adam Gray, at the event he committed to supporting Health4All Kids! This is up for a vote on 8/19/2015. California is the first state to provide medical insurance for undocumented children. Assemblyman Gray also indicated that they would set a date for a gathering to discuss the adult segment of the population, not covered. There were over 100 people at this action.• Senator Lara will be backing SB10 next year, this bill would provide access to medical insurance for undocumented adults.
11:45 – 12:15	<p style="text-align: center;">PIQE & Planada School District Partnership</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lupe Delgado and Teresa Guerrero presented.• PIQE has been in existence since 1987 and has graduated over ½ million parents through their programs.• In addition to their standard 9-week program there are other accompanying programs.• The California Endowment added a health component with the ACA Outreach and Education, as well as a civic engagement component (another 9-week portion)• Lupe has been involved in the schools in Planada since last April
