## OCCUPANCY TYPES

- A1 – Assembly Use
  - Theaters, Symphony Halls, etc.
- A2 – Assembly Use
  - Food & Drink, Banquet Halls, Bars, Restaurants, etc.
- A3 – Assembly Use
  - Churches, Recreation Activities, Amusement Activities, etc.
- A4 – Assembly Use
  - Arenas, Skating Rinks, Swimming Pools, Tennis Courts, etc.
- A5 – Assembly Use
  - Amusement Park Structures, Bleachers, Grandstands, Stadiums
- B – Business Use
  - Offices, Kennels, Car Wash, Outpatient Clinics, Showrooms, Professional Offices, etc.
- E – Educational Use
  - Education through 12<sup>th</sup> grade & day care for ages 2 and up - more than 6 persons.
- F1 – Moderate Hazard Factory
  - Furniture, Machinery, Textiles, Woodworking, Clothing, etc.
- F2 – Low Hazard Factory
  - Beverages >17% alcohol, Foundries, Brick & Masonry, etc.
- H1 – H5 – High Hazard Group
  - High Hazard Occupancies (highly flammable & explosives)
- I2 – Institutional Use
  - Detox Facilities, Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Psychiatric Hospitals, etc.
- I3 – Institutional Use
  - Correctional Centers, Detention Centers, Jails, Prisons, Reformatories, etc.
- I4 – Institutional Use
  - Day Care-<6 Clients & > 24 hrs a day by people not guardians & outside clients home.
- M – Mercantile Use
  - Department Stores, Markets, Drug Stores, Gas Stations, etc.
- R1 – Residential Use
  - Boarding Houses with <10 Persons, Hotels, Motels
- R2 – Residential Use
  - <2 Dwelling Units, Apartments, Dorms, Live/Work Units, Timeshares, etc.
- R3 – Residential Use
  - Single Family Home, Duplex
- R4 – Residential Use
  - Residential Care - >6 but <17 ambulatory clients on 24 hr basis in supervised env.
- S1 – Moderate Hazard Storage
  - Aircraft, Bags, Books, Cardboard, Clothing, Furniture, Grains, Leather, Lumber, Soaps, Upholstery & Mattresses, Vehicle Repair, Tires, Etc.
- S2 – Low Hazard Storage
  - Beverages >17% Alcohol, Empty Cans, Food Products, Food/Non-Combustible Containers, Fruits & Veggies/Non-Plastic Trays, Glass, Metals, Appliances, etc.
- U – Utility & Miscellaneous Use
  - Ag Bldgs. – Pole Barns & Storage Bldgs. For Ag Equipment, Residential Accessory Bldgs., Porches, Patios, & Garages, Fences, Retaining Walls, Tanks, Towers, etc.
