

NOTICE OF CURRENT PROPERTY TAXES DUE

Pursuant to § 2609, Revenue and Taxation



Secured tax bills were mailed on/or about October 14, 2020 to all property owners, at the addresses shown on the tax roll. If you did not receive a 2020-2021 tax bill and own property in Merced County, contact the Tax Collector's Office, at 2222 M Street Merced, CA or call (209) 385-7592.

Failure to receive a tax bill shall not relieve the lien of taxes, nor shall it prevent penalties from being imposed by Revenue & Taxation Code § 2610.5

The **FIRST INSTALLMENT** is due **November 1, 2020** and becomes delinquent (late) if not received by the close of business or postmarked on or before December 10th. A 10% penalty applies to late payments received after this date. If a reminder notice is generated a fee of \$20.00 will also be assessed.

The **SECOND INSTALLMENT** is due on **February 1, 2021** and becomes delinquent (late) if not received by the close of business or postmarked on or before April 10th. A 10% penalty and \$30.00 cost applies to late payments received after this date. If a reminder notice is generated a fee of \$20.00 will also be assessed.

BOTH INSTALLMENTS MAY BE PAID when the first installment is due.

Payments may also be made by calling the toll-free phone system (877) 737-4829, by mail, or in person at the tax collector's office, 2222 M St, Merced, CA. 95340, between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, holidays excepted.

Mailed payments must be **POSTMARKED BEFORE THE DELINQUENT DATE** to avoid late penalties.
