General Instructions

- I. **Severability** (Title 15, Section 1300) - If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phase of this Policy Manual is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, contrary to statute, exceeding the authority of the Board of State and Community Corrections or the policies of the County of Merced, or otherwise inoperative, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of these regulations.
- II. **Other Standards and Requirements** (Title 15, Section 1301) - Any standards and requirements of the City of Merced, the County of Merced, and the Merced County Probation Department may be adopted and incorporated into this Policy Manual regarding the facility and its employees, as long as those standards and requirements meet or exceed and do not conflict with the standards set forth in Title 15 and Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations.
- III. **Definitions** (Title 15, Section 1302 and Title 24, Section 13-201a) - Definitions regarding the policies and procedures contained in this Policy Manual shall conform to the definitions contained in Section 1302 of Title 15 and Section 13-201(a) of Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations.
- IV. **Pilot Projects** (Title 15, Section 1303 and Title 24, Section 13-201c) - Any pilot projects undertaken by the County of Merced, the Merced County Probation Department, and/or Iris Garrett Juvenile Justice Correctional Complex shall conform to the standards and procedures set forth in Section 1303 of Title 15 and Section 13-201(c) of Title 24 of California Code of Regulations.

- V. **Alternate Means of Compliance** (Title 15, Section 1304 and Title 24, Section 13-201c)
Applications for alternate means of compliance shall be submitted to the Board of State and Community Corrections in the manner and format described in Title 15, Section 1304, and in Title 24, Section 13-201(c) of the California Code of Regulations.
