MARTIN QUEVEDO SEGURA GUILTY of 7
COUNTS of LEWD and LASCIVIOUS ACTS
AGAINST a MINOR



On April 15, 2022 a Merced jury returned guilty verdicts against Martin Quevedo Segura (Merced Superior Court case 18CR-06489). Mr. Segura was charged with three counts of lewd and lascivious acts against a minor under the age of ten in violation of Penal Code 288.7(b) and seven counts of lewd and lascivious acts against a minor in violation of Penal Code section 288(a). The defendant was found not guilty of the charges alleging that the minor was under the age of ten, and guilty of the seven other charges. The acts occurred from 2016 through 2018. The jury heard testimony and evidence in the courtroom of Honorable Judge Ronald Hansen from April 5th through April 14th, including testimony from the minor victim, the minor's mother, and a nurse who physically examined the victim. Sentencing is scheduled for July 19, 2022. Mr. Segura faces up to 20 years in state prison. Deputy District Attorney Tracy Roland prosecuted the case.
